Calmsley Hill City Farm Kindergarten Excursion

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This term in Science, Kindergarten students are completing activities on the unit 'Staying Alive'. In their studies, the students are exploring the needs and wants of animals and themselves. To help the students gain a better understanding of needs and wants, we have planned an excursion to Calmsley Hill City Farm for **Tuesday, 12th November 2019**. On the day, a guide employed by the farm will talk to the students about the needs of the animals. Students will then have the opportunity to handle baby ducklings, chicks and rabbits. We will walk around the farm, where we will see and feed the larger animals and milk a cow.

We will be leaving school at 9:15am on the morning of the excursion, so we ask that your child is at school by **9:00am** to ensure that class rolls are marked and that we are away on time. We will return to school before the bell at 3:10pm.

Morning tea, lunch and drinks (no glass bottles or cans please) will need to be provided in a small backpack. Please ensure that your child wears full school uniform. The students will be accompanied on this excursion by their class teachers.

Cost for the excursion will be **\$30.00**, which covers entry and bus transport to and from Calmsley Hill City Farm. This amount needs to be paid by **Monday, 29th September 2019**.
