

Learning Highlights Worm Juice

Stage 2 have been investigating the Living World and learning about worms. They've learnt about their life cycle, habit, diet and their importance to our ecosystem. Thanks to a donation from Bunnings, they now have an operational worm farm with 1000 worms (plus the other 653 worms that students 'rescued' during the rain last week!!).

Through research and an investigation, students have learned how brilliant worm juice is for gardens. As part of the unit, students have been learning a bit about marketing and our aim is to start selling the worm juice to teachers and parents next term. The money raised will go towards items such as garden beds, plants and outdoor learning spaces throughout the school. Students have voted on a name for the worm juice to make it sound a little more appealing and they've decided on 'Garden Goods'!
