Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Schofields Public School

A project is underway to redevelop Schofields Public School. The project will deliver new flexible learning spaces and upgraded facilities where the existing school facilities were located including:

- 27 new flexible learning spaces
- A new staff/administration area
- A new library
- Upgraded amenities
- A new covered outdoor learning area (COLA).

Progress summary

 The project is anticipated to be completed in Term 3, 2020 in preparation for a Day 1, Term 4 start

- The internal fittings and fixtures for the new buildings continue to be installed including flooring and carpeting, joinery, and lighting. Furniture has also started being delivered.
- External works including landscaping are underway. Asphalt has been poured for the netball courts and construction of the On-Site Detention tank (OSD) and covered outdoor learning area (COLA) has finished
- The feature brick wall on the St Albans Road side of the school is complete and pedestrian access will be permanently changed as a result of this new structure

Next steps

It is anticipated that relocation into the new buildings will commence during the Term 3 holidays with the new facilities ready for staff and students at the start of Term 4. Until then, on site work will continue including finalising the landscaping, painting and commissioning of services to deliver a fully functional school.
