Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Schofields Public School

A project is underway to redevelop Schofields Public School to accommodate the growing student population in the area, with new flexible learning spaces and upgraded facilities to be built where the existing school facilities were located.

Progress summary

During Term 3, footings for the new two-storey building have been excavated and the first ground floor slab has been poured.

In addition, new shade sails have been installed in the temporary school and extra seating has been provided.

Blacktown Council has also completed the bus bay on Junction Road.

Next steps

During the school holidays and Term 4, the ground floor slabs will be completed and concrete columns poured, ahead of the installation of first floor slabs and the steel structure for the upper storey.

Stormwater pipes will also be laid, and some minor landscaping works will be undertaken.

Construction of the On-Site Detention Tank will commence soon. Temporary access has been provided between the temporary school and the Hall for disabled and pram access while the permanent ramp is fenced off.
