
SCHOOL BUS 6525 - PM SERVICE

Commencing Monday 14th October 2019, there will be a temporary path change to School Bus 6525 due to roadworks on Boundary Road between Mesik Street and Kensington Park Road, Schofields.

PLEASE NOTE: This temporary change will continue to operate throughout Term 4 and Busways will provide further notification advising of a date when the service will return to normal.


